

CONTEXT MENUS

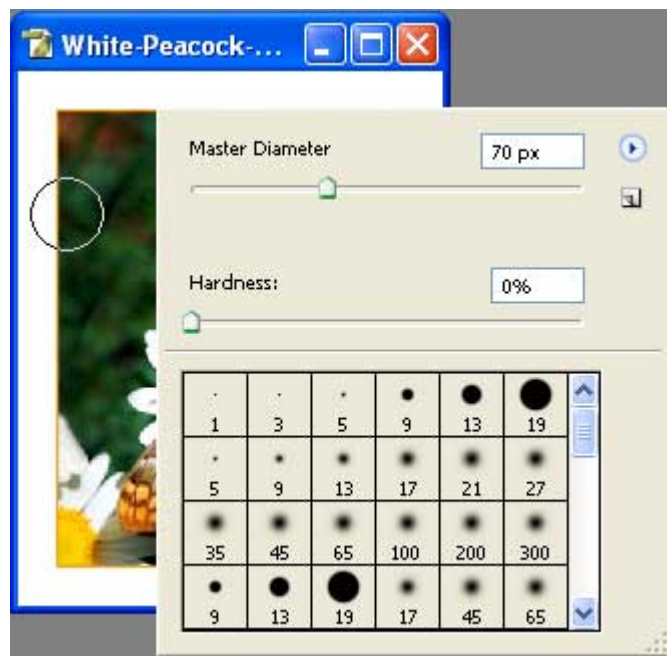
Using context menus saves you a lot of time. They are accessed on a PC by Right Clicking or Control Clicking on a Mac. There are Context Menus everywhere! Right Click/Control Click on the title bar of an image for instance. Try to remember to bring up Context Menus with every tool. Once any tool is active, you can access most of its features by Right Clicking/Control Clicking. One Context Menu that I use a lot is with Transform as shown below. Also, with the Move tool active, you'll see what layers are in that area. You can then activate any layer by clicking on the desired one. No need to go over to the layers palette! Right Click/Control Click when you have a brush active and it brings up your brushes palette. It's really a timesaver and a good reason for Mac people to consider buying a two button mouse!
