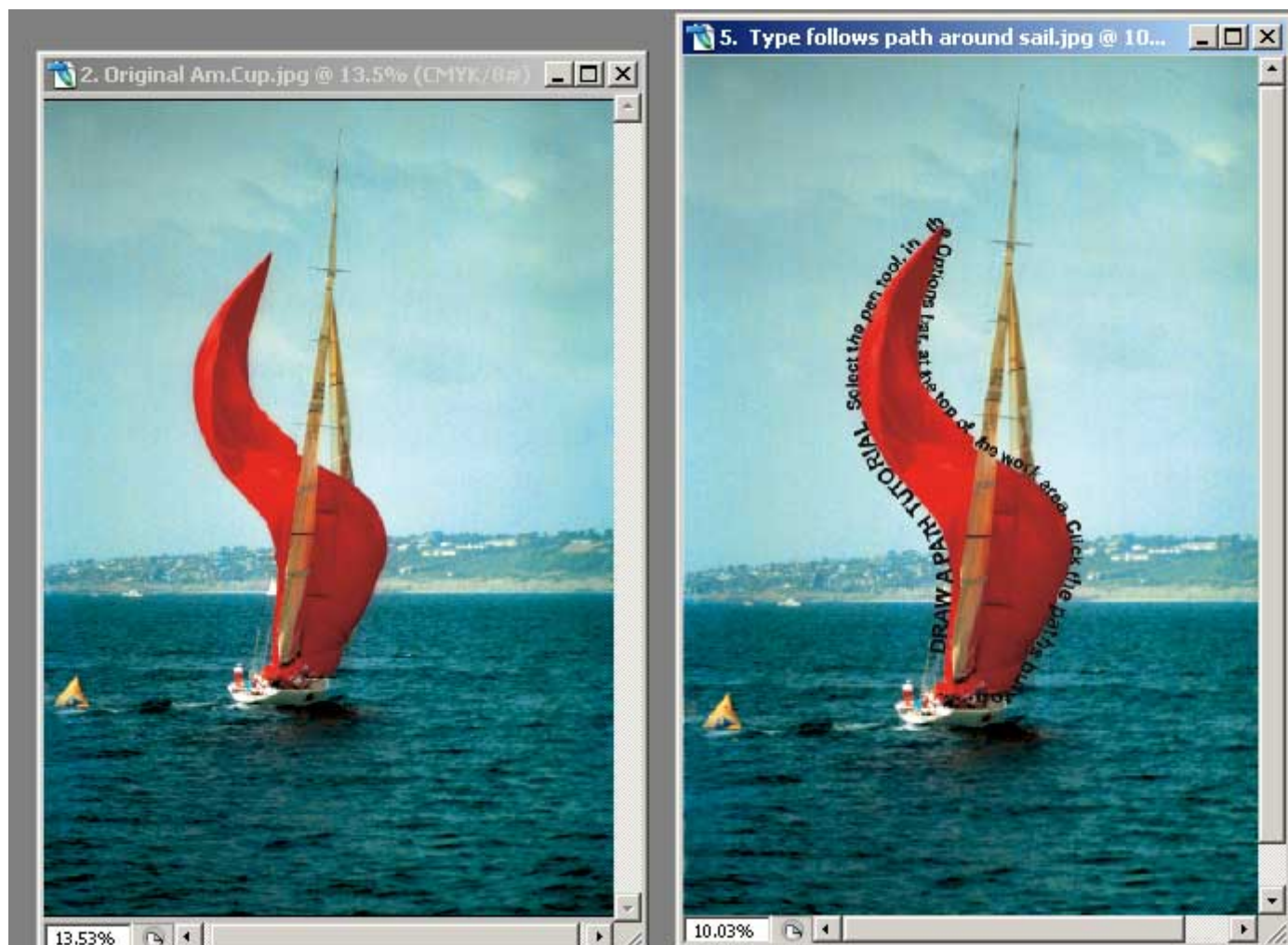


Type On a Path – presented by Carol Abel



1. Select the Pen Tool in the Tool Box. In the Options bar at the top of the work area, click the middle option which is "paths".



2. Using the pen tool, click on a desired area to set the first point of the path of a curve. Continue to set down these points by clicking all along your subject.
3. When you get all the way around and your cursor comes close to your first click point, you' will see a tiny circle. Click when you see this circle. The path will close. It looks kind of like a selection but is a solid line.
4. Select the Type Tool. Choose a font and size suitable for the image. Choose a color that will show up on your image.
5. Position your cursor over any part of the path and move the cursor until you see a little "squiggly" line with a line crossed through it under the cursor icon. This indicates you are about to type on a path. When you see the cursor change, click and begin typing. Your type will magically follow your path.

6. When you are finished, click on the check mark at the right side of the top options bar.
